

LETTER FROM THE FOUNDER

In April 1983, the American Gathering of Holocaust Survivors and Descendants hosted more than 20,000 attendees in Washington, D.C. In April 1985, the Canadian Gathering of Holocaust Survivors and Descendants hosted 5,000 attendees in Ottawa. Both events were modeled after a similar event, held in Israel in 1981, which hosted 15,000 attendees. Since then, these events have not been repeated.

I attended the Canadian Gathering with my late father, a Hungarian Holocaust Survivor. The event was a turning point for me - an opportunity to identify as a "descendant," and meet other children of survivors with shared experiences. More importantly, the Gathering instilled in me a life-long commitment to Holocaust remembrance and education.

It has since been my dream to mobilize another Global Gathering, to inspire others to continue this important work into the future. Now, as we lose our cherished survivors, the need is greater than ever.

Please join me in making this once-in-a-lifetime event a reality. 75 years in 2020 is the right time.

WHAT IS LIBERATION 75?

Liberation75: Global Gathering of Holocaust Survivors, Descendants, Educators and Friends, is a not-for-profit event dedicated to commemorating and celebrating the 75th anniversary of liberation from the Holocaust. It will be held on May 31-June 2, 2020, in Toronto, Canada. We anticipate approximately 3,500 attendees from around the world plus 7,500 students and 600 teachers.

We are at a crucial point in history as we experience the steady loss of our survivor witnesses, a digital world where information is shared quickly (though often inaccurately), a significant rise in antisemitism and anti-Israel sentiments, and a surge of interest in Holocaust testimonies, lessons, imagery, remembrance and education.

Liberation 75 will focus on remembering the victims, honouring the survivors, showcasing the future of Holocaust education, reflecting on antisemitism in the world, celebrating the role of the liberators, educating students and teachers, and committing to protect freedom, diversity, human rights and inclusion. It will also be the largest "descendants" conference in 35 years.

As Elie Wiesel said: "Only in remembering what happened to us, can the world assure that it will not happen to others."

MOTIVATE

- To motivate 7,500 students and hundreds of teachers to continue exploring the lessons of the Holocaust in a world without survivor witnesses so they can use this education to fight antisemitism
- To organize a citywide event, where various organizations host Liberation75 attendees in a special evening of "dine-around" dinners and programming

CELEBRATE

 To create a not-for-profit event to celebrate the 75th anniversary of liberation from the Holocaust

- To bring together approximately 3,500 attendees, including 2nd generation, 3rd generation, educators and students – to learn, discuss, commemorate, and commit to human rights

- · To allow 7,500 students and general attendees to interact with Holocaust survivors for perhaps the last time

- To pass descendants the torch of remembrance and inspire them to carry their parents' and grandparents' stories into the future
- To allow remaining survivors to tell their stories to others, participate in Holocaust-related activities and inspire the next generation

HONOUR

- To recognize and celebrate the role of World War II liberators
- To honour Holocaust survivors at our Opening by committing to telling their stories into the future



WHY TORONTO
